On Saturday, March 19th some of our Committee Members manned a stall at the 'Community Day' at the Ladyholme Centre, giving us the opportunity to meet up with local residents and friends to create awareness of Twinning opportunities and activities planned for 2016, and we were pleased with the level of interest on the day.

This year a small number of players from the Blasergruppe will be arriving on Saturday 14th May, relaxing on arrival with a meal and a visit to Hawkshead Brewery in Staveley. As a further date for your diaries, we will be having a fund raising Coffee Morning at the Marchesi Centre on Saturday 21st May from 10.00am to 11.30am and as always, contributions for a stall or raffle would be welcome. However, as the event will also focus on the St Cuthbert's Parents' Committee raising funds towards the purchase of Glockenspiels for the school, there will be a special stall of home produce and cakes and other baked goodies made by the ladies from the Church and the School, so clearly a opportunity not to be missed for you and your friends!

Please also note the date for our annual Strawberries and Pimms Garden Party at the Fairfield Hotel on 25th June.
